

**LIST OF DOS AND DON'TS FOR LICENSED COMPANIES
FOR MM2H PROGRAMME**

▪ **Permitted activities:**

- Promote and market the programme by providing Accurate and up-to-date information to potential clients
- Offer application services to interested applicants and payment of such services should not be more than the maximum limit that has been set by the Ministry of Tourism.
- Offer other services to successful applicants and ensure that they are well aware of the amount of fee that they have to pay and the time that you need to fulfill those services. They should not be any hidden charges once the client has accepted your services. Prepare a contract for every service offered.
- Act as a guarantor to the foreigners (permitted to Sign the “Personal Bond” form)
- Can have a foreign partner, holding not more than 30% share holding in the company

▪ **Restricted activities :**

- Promising foreigners Permanent Residence (PR) or citizenship status.
- Promising employment/business opportunities to foreigners.
- Compel foreigners to purchase residential units as a pre-requisite before they can submit their application to stay in Malaysia under this programme.
- Act with other parties with intention to cheat participants of MM2H especially in house purchase, purchase of car etc.
- Asking for inducement to `bribe' MM2H's officers.
